Forsyth purchased the winning ticket for the group through Subscription Spot. They won their prize in the Gold Ball Draw by matching the selection in the LOTTO 6/49 September 11 draw: **38272561-01** a white ball.

When Forsyth received the phone call from WCLC about the win on the September 11 draw—she started calling everyone else up to share the news.

"They all said the same thing," she laughed. "'Oh my god!'"

"We had cheers and giggles, and a few asked if it was real."

And this group knows how to spread joy. After meeting for years to enjoy wine and laughter in each other's company, they're ready to enjoy even more together.

"Everybody thinks it's better than we even imagined," beamed Gordon-Cooper. "We're mostly 60-plus years old here. One gal already put a deposit on a new car!"
